

## **Agincourt Resources Ensures Martabe TSF Remains Safe and Stable Following Extreme Rainfall in November 2025**

**Jakarta, 7 December 2025** – PT Agincourt Resources (PTAR), operator of the Martabe Gold Mine, provides a public update regarding the condition of the Tailings Storage Facility (TSF) following the extreme and unprecedented rainfall that occurred from 24 to 26 November 2025.

### **Overall Condition of the TSF:**

PTAR firmly affirms that the Martabe **TSF remains safe, stable, and operating normally**. The TSF was designed to withstand extreme rainfall events, and its performance during this incident has been validated by an independent dam engineering consultant.

### **Summary of Rainfall and TSF Performance:**

- **Rainfall Event:** Recorded rainfall over the 72 hours (24–26 November 2025) exceeded **500 mm**, an event not seen in at least the past 50 years.
- **Dam Performance:** Despite experiencing exceptionally high rainfall, the TSF embankment performed satisfactorily.
- **Inspections:** Both PTAR teams and independent consultants conducted continuous inspections through direct observations and real-time monitoring instruments to ensure the TSF remained in a safe condition.

PTAR continues to closely monitor the situation and coordinate with the relevant authorities. We reaffirm that **the safety and integrity of the Martabe TSF are fully maintained to support the continuation of operational activities**.
